

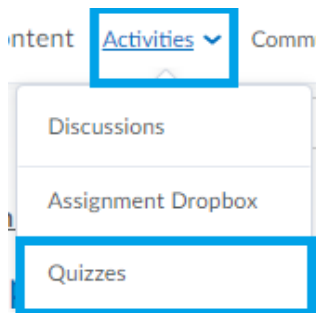
Printing a quiz

These instructions explain how to print out a quiz from Brightspace to provide a hard-copy of your assessment. You may find this useful if you want to review questions on paper or if you need to provide a student a paper copy of an assessment.

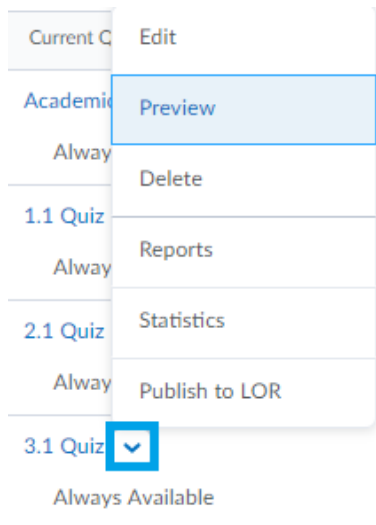
Note:

- Make sure you set the quiz to show all the questions on the same page. If your quiz is set up for multiple pages, only the questions displayed on the page you set up to print will print.
- If your quiz is set up for random selection of quiz questions, this will not work, as it will only display one set of randomly selected questions.

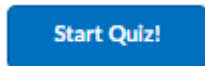
Select Activities → Quizzes to view all quizzes in the course



Select the arrow next to the quiz/exam you would like to print and click “Preview”



Scroll through the instructions and select “Start Quiz” and click “OK” on the Confirmation screen



Confirmation



The quiz you are about to begin may take a few minutes to load.

The timer will not begin until after the set up process is finished.

If you submit your responses after the time limit expires, your attempt will be recorded as a late submission.

Click OK to start your quiz or click Cancel if you do not wish to start it now.

In the preview window, highlight all quiz questions and answers, then copy (ctrl+c) and paste (ctrl+v) into a Word document and print.
