## Introduction


- There may be cases where the library has created a useful report, chart or graph in Alma analytics and certain librarians will want to run it.
- The option here of creating an "Analytics Object" of type "Report" allows the librarian to run an Alma Analytics report "on demand".
- This differs from the "Scheduled Report" because it is not sent by mail.
- This differs from the widget because it does not appear on the dashboard.
- The advantage here is that a librarian can run a report without entering Alma Analytics

#### Introduction

- In our case we will use a report of the average time a vendor takes to send an ordered item.
- The report is called "SS Items ordered with sent date and receiving date and TIMESTAMPDIFF and average" in directory "/Shared Folders/Alma University/Reports/Igelu 2014/"
- We will call the Analytics object report "Average arrival time by vendor"



## Creating an analytics object


 From the Alma menu under the "Administration" column we will choose "Analytics > Configuration Menu"






## Creating an analytics object

 Then we will choose "Analytics Object List" and "Add new Analytics Object"








## Creating an analytics object
