1.1. Purpose and Scope

The purpose of this document is to describe the functional and technical changes included in this Service Pack (SP) and to provide implementation instructions where appropriate.

MetaLib Service Pack 4.0.7 (217-233), September 2007.

1.1.2. Service Pack Highlights

This Service Pack includes 14 items, 11 corrections, two enhancements, and one technical change. There are several corrections for the X Server and six corrections for the User Interface.

There are **no** items requiring mandatory implementation actions. There is one optional implementation item related to Internet Explorer 7 browser behavior. The rest are automatically applied by the Service Pack mechanism.

3. Detailed Implementation Instructions

3.1. Item 227 – Vertical Scroll Bar in IE7 (Optional)

Note: This manual change is relevant only to customers upgrading from MetaLib Version 3.13 who have already run Upgrade Express prior to installing this Service Pack.

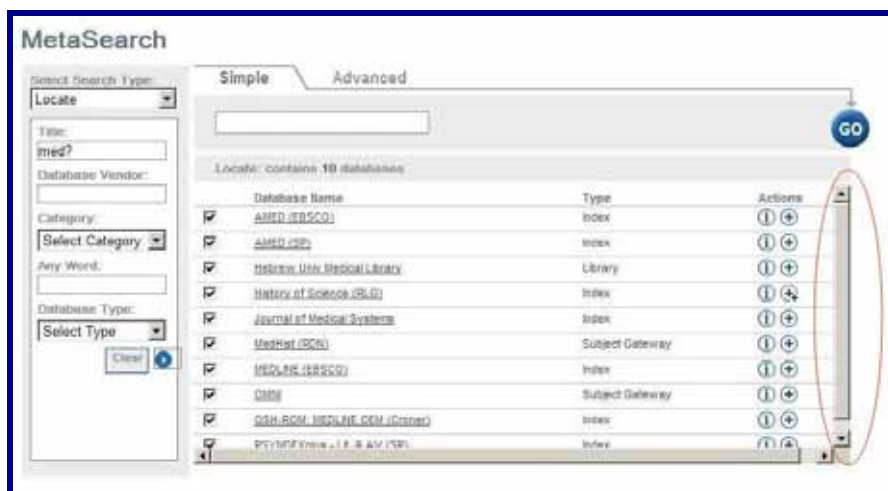


Figure 1. Manual Change for Vertical Scroll Bar in IE7

Following are the implementation instructions to display the vertical scroll bar in the Database List in the MetaSearch ► Locate module:

For all instances and languages, in the file

```
./insNN/www_v_<lng>/metalib.css
```

change the line from:

```
#record_list_metasearch {width:100%;height:259px;overflow:auto}
```

to:

```
#record_list_metasearch  
{width:100%;height:259px;overflow:auto;overflow-y:scroll}
```
