Overview & Benefits

- Provides a more visually appealing and dynamic funding landing page when users first log into Pivot
- Showcases the breadth of funding in Pivot by keyword/topic
- Makes it easier to zoom in on funding leveraging controlled vocabulary keywords
- Offers more intuitive way to build complex, multi-keyword queries without having to use the Advanced search form

New funding “home page”

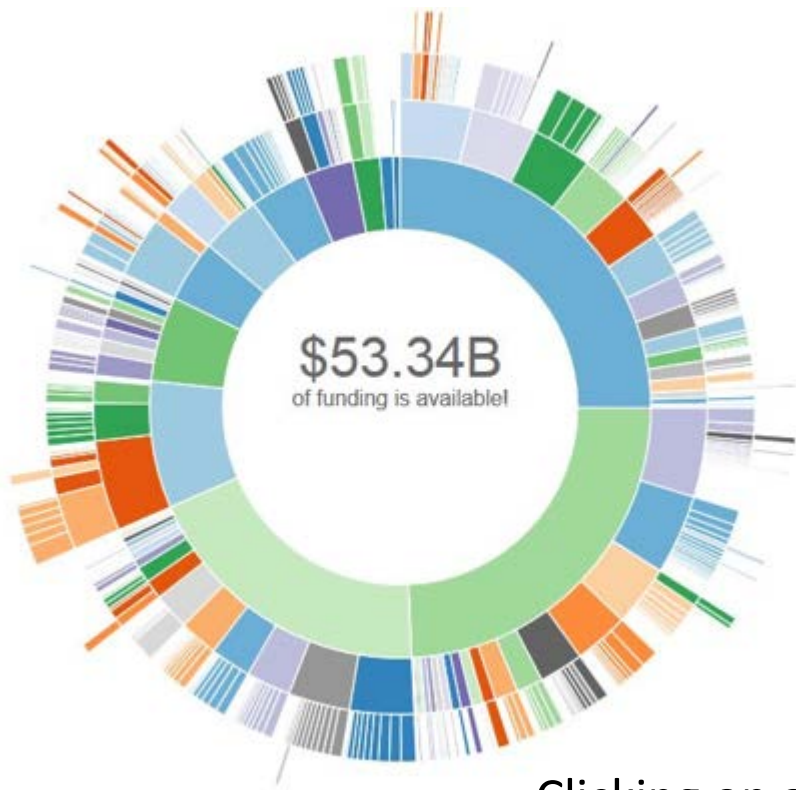

Browse by Keyword


When a user hovers over the interactive graphic, they can see the total funding available by keyword displayed dynamically.



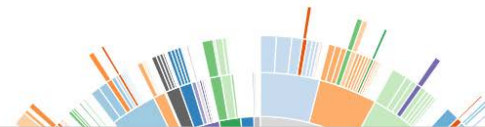
Clicking on a keyword topic will return all the search results in Pivot associated with that keyword

Search by Keyword

- The new search by keyword tab allows users to navigate and select keywords using a hierarchical keyword menu tree
- Typing keywords provides autocomplete suggestions
- Users can choose multiple keywords to search at once

Search results include “Exploded” Keywords

Keyword searches automatically display matches to “exploded keywords” meaning that Pivot includes results for all the more specific keywords that are lower in the keyword hierarchy.

For example, searching ‘Education’ includes terms such as ‘Higher Education’, ‘Literacy’, etc.
