Streaming Videos Management

- ✓ Support for streaming video titles live in the February 2019 release
- Content Operations team will onboard providers throughout the year
- Next phases:
 - ✓ Management Reports integration
 - Discovery rights integration
 - Normalization for 360 MARC Updates
 - E-Journal Portal UI refinements
 - Overlap Analysis



Expanded Integration with ProQuest Ebook Central

- Extend auto-holdings management from the Perpetual & DDA collection to ALL ebook subscriptions
- Opt-in to a new collection dedicated to discovery for all EBC titles
- Target rollout is August release



Support for New Standards

- COUNTER Code of Practice r5
 - New Project COUNTER CoP aims to streamline and simplify exchange of usage statistics
- 360 Counter and Intota Projects:
 - ✓ Analyze report data and trends as providers become compliant
 - Ingest “master” reports
 - SUSHI JSON
- CoP r5 support is top priority!



Support for New Standards

- KBART

- NISO standard for Knowledge Bases and Related Tools will be incorporated into
 - Internal KB ingestion tools
 - Export (both 360 Core Client Center and Intota)
- KBART Automation standard is out for review
 - Codifies the exchange of e-resource holdings data between a provider and the ERM
 - Will allow us to extend auto-holdings using an industry standard
