## Key Benefits

- Admins can now choose which curated lists and searches to publicly display for all users at your institution. Previously, all curated lists were always viewable by all users on the curated tab.
  - Pivot Gallery users can now link through to the Pivot profile editor from their Gallery profiles in order to make updates to their profiles

# Display Options for Curated Content

# Public Display of Curated Lists

- Currently every curated list or curated search created by a Pivot admin displays publicly on the “Curated tab” where it is visible by all users at your institution
- With this release, **Admins will now be able to choose** which of their curated lists or curated searches **to display or hide from public view**



# New: Display Toggle for Curated Lists and Searches



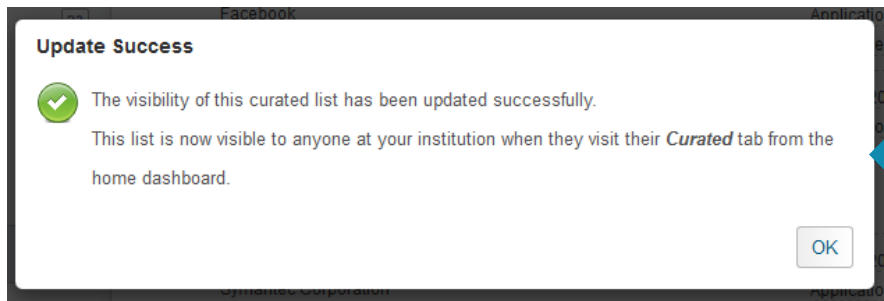

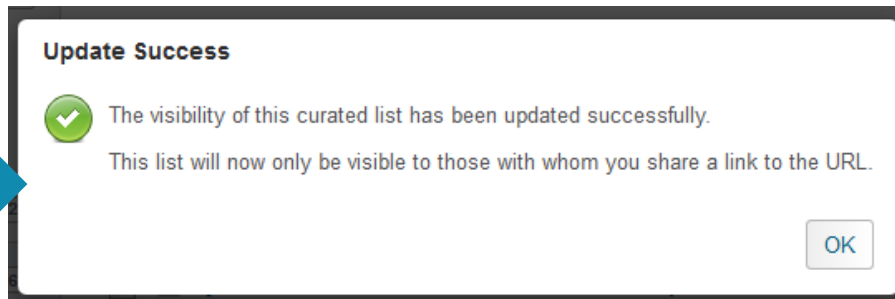


**If Deselected**, the list will only display privately for you, and not on the curated tab.



# Sharing Curated Lists and Searches via a Link

If Deselected, the list will only display privately for you, and not on the curated tab. **However, it can still be accessed by anyone with whom you share a link to the URL for this list**

# Notes: Existing lists vs. New lists

Display  

Since current curated lists and curated searches already display publicly for your users, all lists created prior to this release **will continue to display publicly** by default. If you wish to now make an existing list hidden from users on the curated tab you will need to deselect the display toggle.


Display  

Newly created curated lists and searches **will not be displayed publicly** unless you actively select the Display toggle. The default setting for any new curated list is “not displayed.”

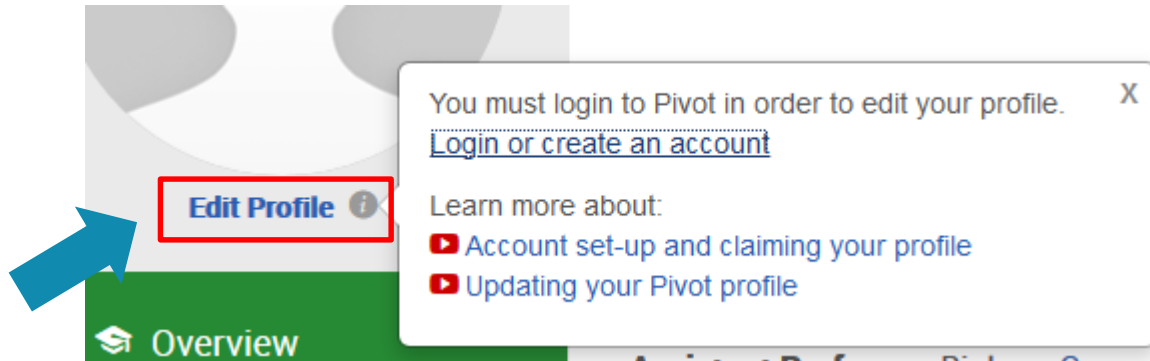

# Pivot Gallery: Edit Profile Workflow



- If coming from Pivot Gallery users who select “Edit Profile” will be directed to login to their Pivot account which will redirect them to the Pivot profile editor.
- Any edits made in the Pivot profile editor will then display in both Pivot and Pivot Gallery in real time (upon a screen re-fresh)

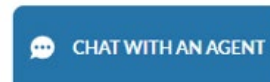


