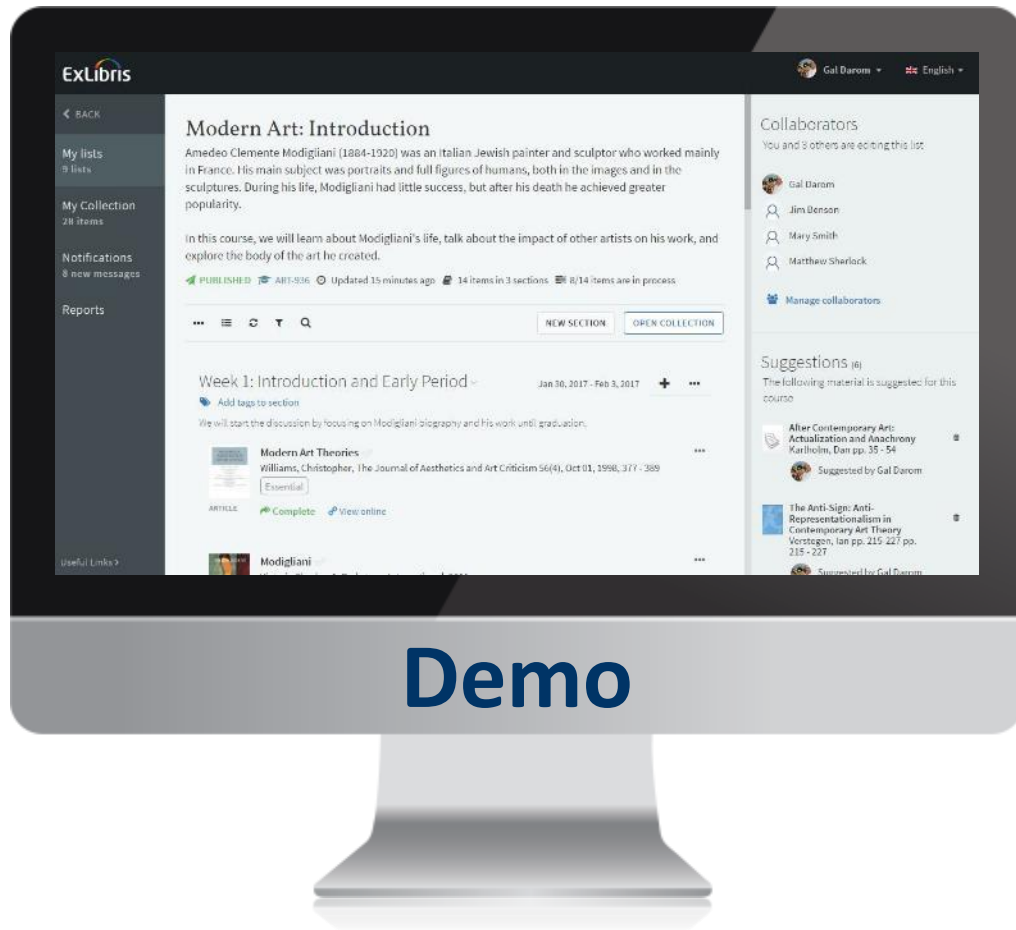

Update a Set of Citations Using a Job

The following changes can be made in bulk to all members of a set of citations:

- Deleting citations
- Setting the citation status
- Setting a due date
- Removing and adding tags
- Removing alerts
- Deleting a public note
- Detaching a citation from the repository
- Removing files



Synchronizing Citations with Repository

Update citation information when the bibliographic record is updated

- Update bibliographic records, for example, when brief order records are overlaid with a full record
- Report on and handle citations where the library record has been deleted

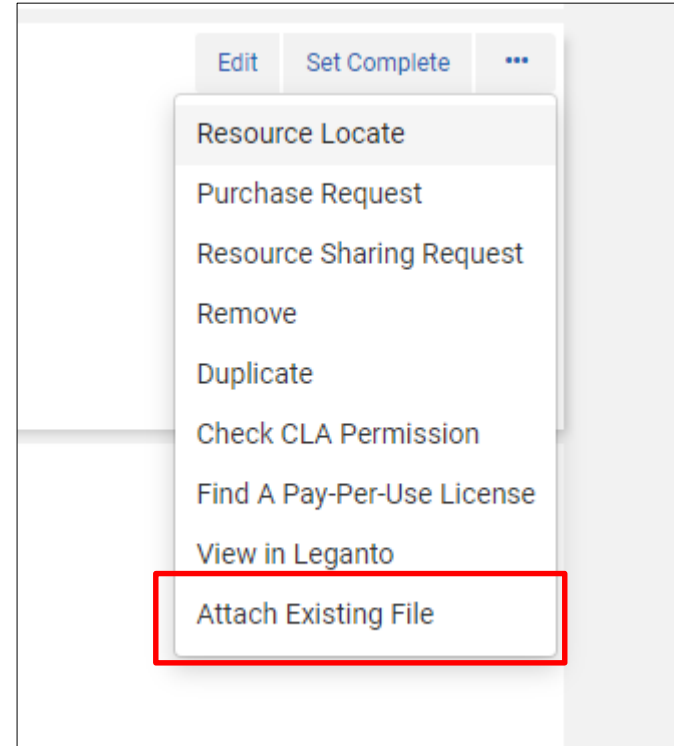

Remote Learning Enablement

Reuse Files for Digitization Requests

- New action on the citation to search scans that already exist in Alma
- Review matching resources and select relevant file
- The citation is then updated to point to the same file.



Making Course-Related Decisions

Library Insights on Usage

- Report on items with high or low usage, compared to the number of physical copies or concurrent user licenses
- Use this information to make informed collection decisions

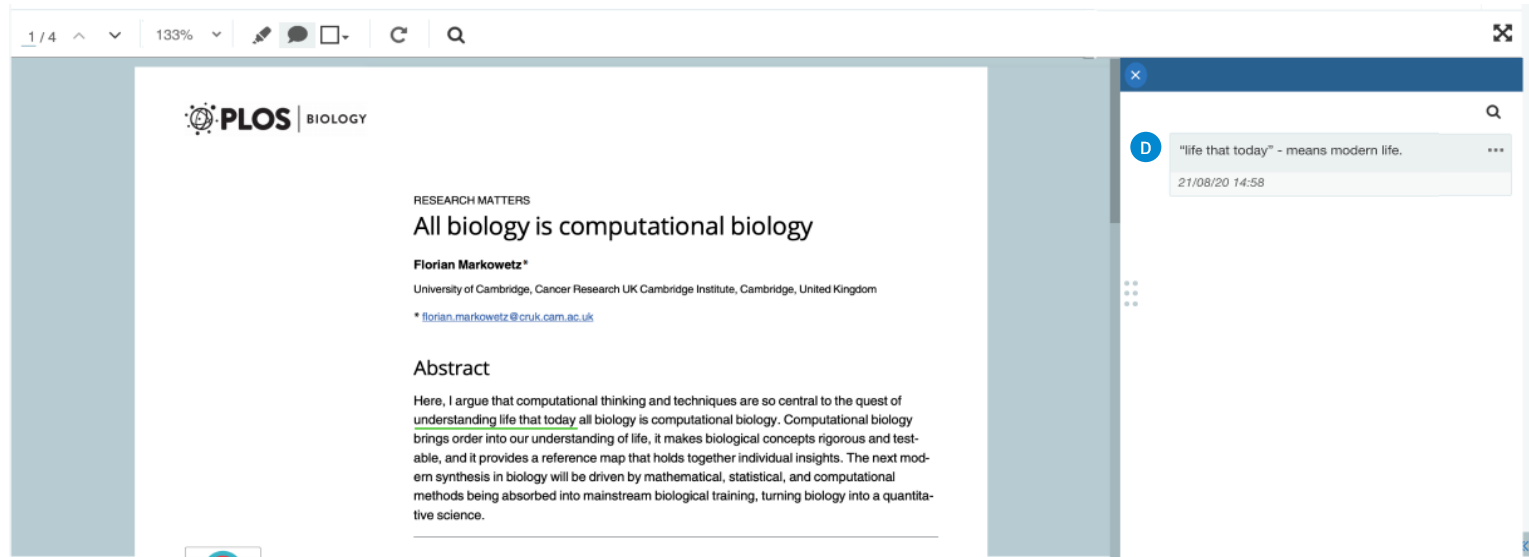

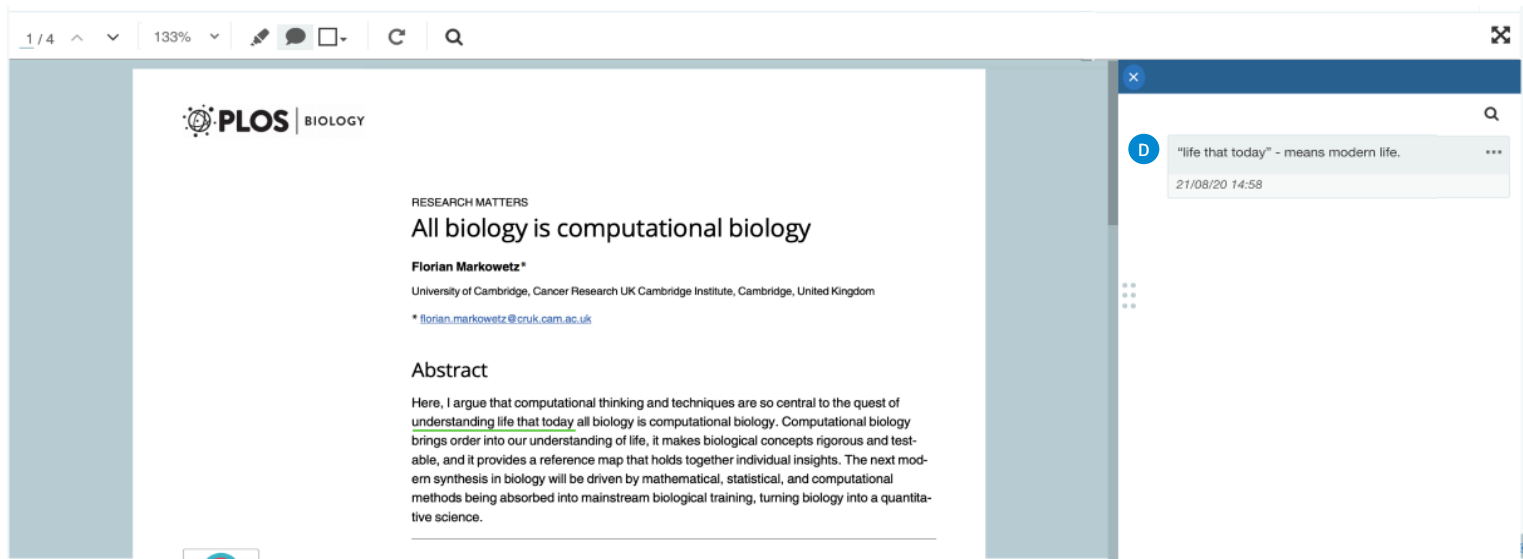
Social Reading (Upcoming)
