New Features, Add-ons, and Integrations

- **Improved R3Search**
 - R3Search only uses a single index for the entire system, which greatly increases system speed and scalability. Adding ACLs will not reduce performance.
 - Date fields can now be displayed as hierarchies. Dates can also use dynamic ranges: “last month,” “last year,” etc.
- **New Widget: Metrics**

The Metrics widget allows administrators to visually track and analyze MediaBeacon usage patterns over time.
- **New Widget: Facet Graph**

Facet Graph allows users to visually browse fields and see what proportion of assets are tagged with different values.
- **New Web Interface**
 - The default web interface in MediaBeacon has a flat, streamlined look.
 - The web interface loads faster, thanks to coding and styling optimizations.
- **Direct Links to Assets**

Users can get links directly to specific assets via the contextual menu.
- **Updated Pre-Extended View**

Information from Extended View has been consolidated into Pre-Extended View.
- **Redesigned Metadata Tabs**

Metadata tabs display in a more organized and efficient manner in the relevant windows.
- **Infinite Scroll**

The Infinite Scroll View adds more assets every time a user reaches the bottom, eliminating the need for paging.
- **Expanded Administrative Tools**
 - Administrators can access server logs and other information directly through the web interface.
 - Administrators can track workflow status and the system’s file action queue through the web interface, as well as stop in-progress workflows if necessary.



- **Search & Selection Bundles**
Searches and selections can be saved as bundle assets, which load the search/selection when double-clicked.
- **Live Metadata Updates**
If another user updates an asset while you're viewing it, MediaBeacon will show the change live without refreshing the page.
- **More Interface Languages**
MediaBeacon has additional interface translations: German, Italian, Brazilian Portuguese, and traditional Chinese.
- **Improved Workflow**
MediaBeacon workflows now support RESTful services.
- **Java 7 Support**
MediaBeacon now requires Java 7.
- **Improved API**
The client-side API includes a variety of updates and new functionality.
