ABBYY FineReader Engine 9 Technology Update

You may need to update to ABBYY FineReader 9 before using this product. To update to this version of ABBYY FineReader, install KFS 4.0 Service Pack 1 Fix Pack 3 and apply FIX 4.0.1.3.RA0379. Contact your administrator for additional information on obtaining this update. (SPR00148811)

For installation information see `ReadMe-KFS-4.0.1.3.RA0379.txt` that is packaged with the fix.

Workaround: None

Unhandled Exception When Reading the Config file

When attempting to extract data from an image, the extraction service fails when trying to read the `Kofax.OCR.config` file. This is caused by a security block added by Windows when the installation zip file was downloaded from the internet. (SPR00116936)

Affected platforms and/or devices:

- Web Services

Workaround: Use the Properties window to “Unblock” the file before unzipping it.

Using the Default Value for the serverURL Causes Error 404

When the `serverURL` default value `<http://localhost:80>` in `ExtractionServiceAdmin.exe.config` is used, the following is returned during a Web services call. (SPR00116209)

```
**** Exception *** The remote server returned an error: (404) Not Found."
```

Affected platforms and/or devices:

- Web Services

Workaround: Use the actual IP address.
