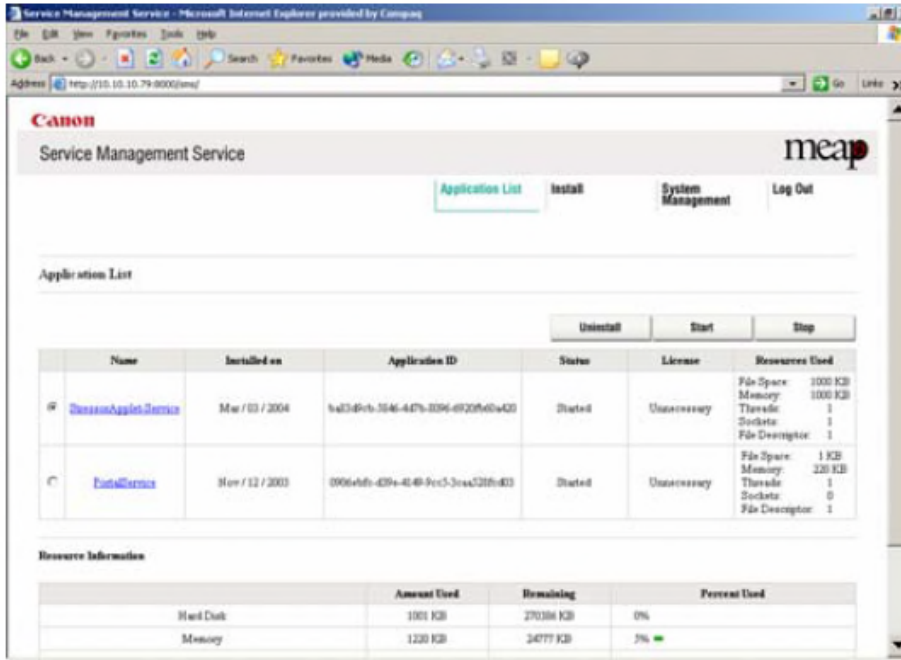
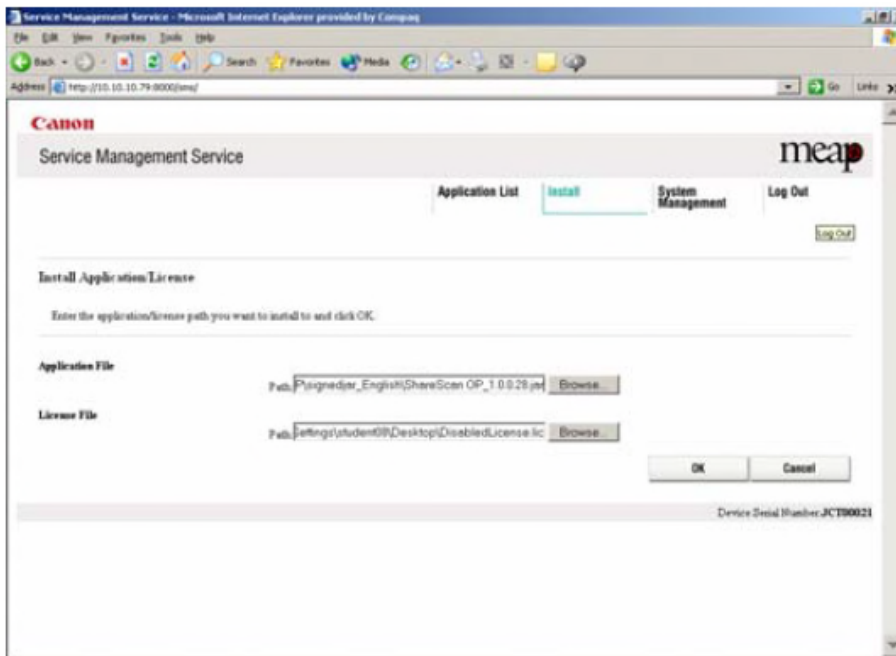


Installing ShareScan Canon MEAP JAR for v4 and v5

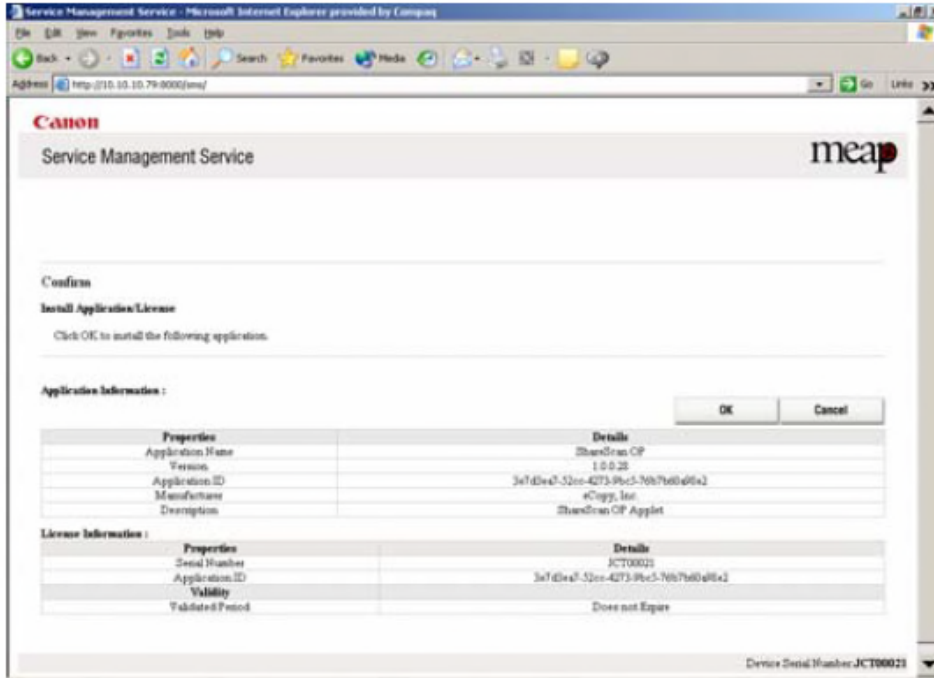
The first step is to access the Service Management Service (SMS) module of the MEAP device. This is done using a standard browser window and connecting to HTTP:\\IP_address:8000\sms. The 8000 is the port Canon has designated for communicating with the SMS module. Login to the SMS using the MEAP device password.



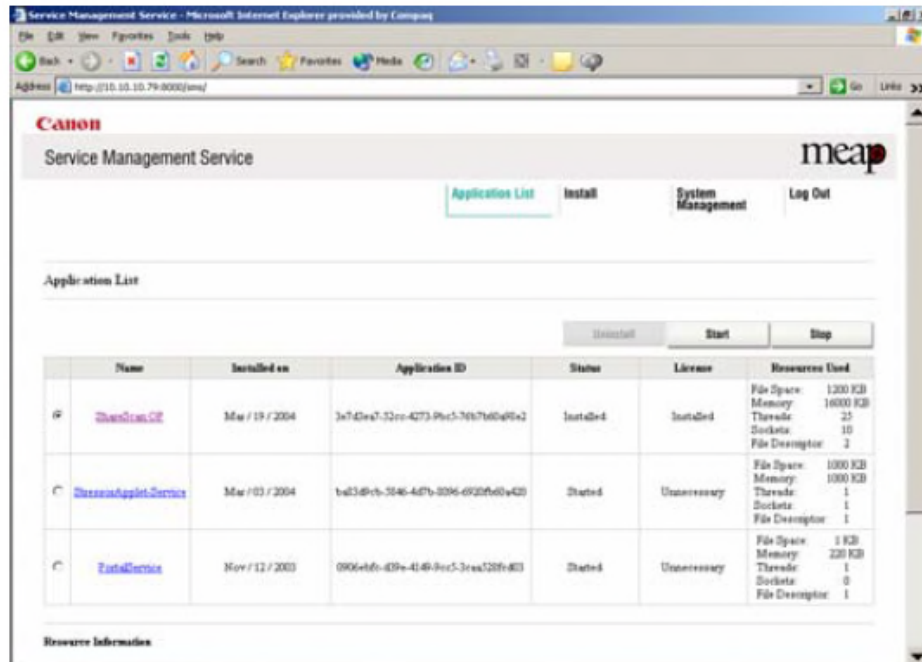
In the Service Management Service module click install.



Browse to the JAR file and the downloaded license file.



Install the JAR and confirm that the install is complete.



Start the MEAP application.

Uninstalling and reinstalling the ShareScan Canon MEAP JAR for v4 and v5

eCopy ShareScan **must** be uninstalled correctly or the current JAR – License file combination **cannot** be reloaded on that MEAP device. All sales engineers, systems engineers and support personnel **must** be aware of the steps required to properly remove the application and, when necessary, reinstall it.

Overview of the Uninstall Process

- Open the MEAP device Service Management Service (SMS) module on the device.
- Stop the ShareScan OP application
- Click on the application name (ShareScan OP)
- Click on the License Management button
- Disable the license and confirm
- Download the license
- Delete the license and confirm
- Uninstall ShareScan Op
- Reboot the device

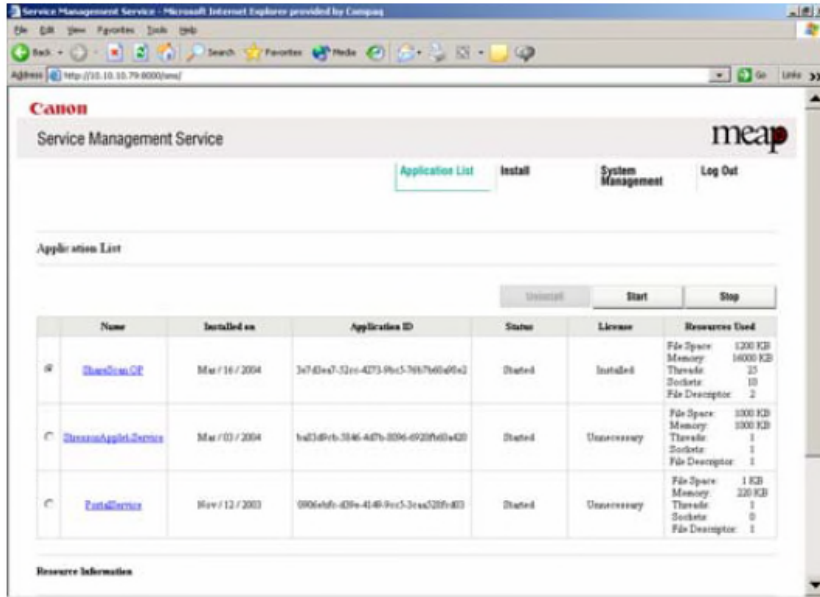
To Reinstall

- Open the MEAP device Service Management Service (SMS) module on the device.
- Click install
- Browse to the JAR file and the downloaded license file
- Install and confirm
- Start the application.

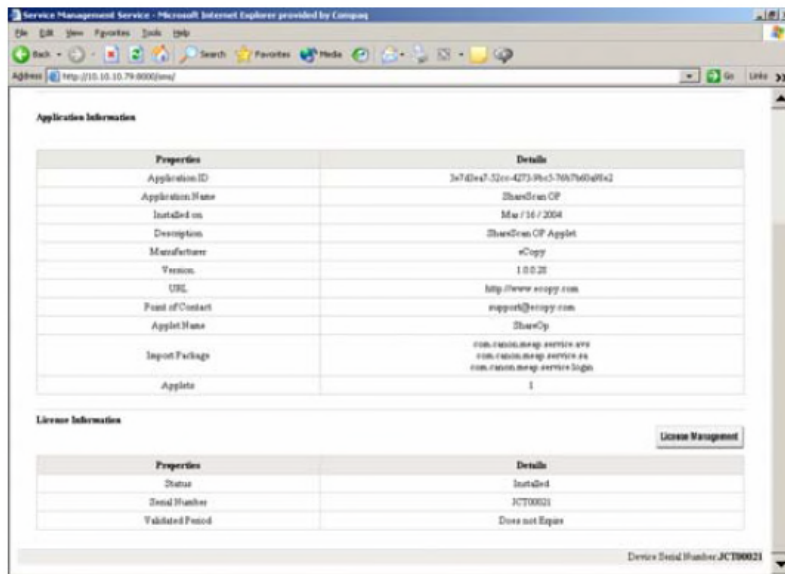
Detailed Description of the Removal/Reinstall Process

The first step is to access the Service Management Service (SMS) module of the MEAP device. This is done using a standard browser window and connecting to `HTTP:\\IP_address:8000\sms`. The 8000 is the port Canon has designated for communicating with the SMS module.

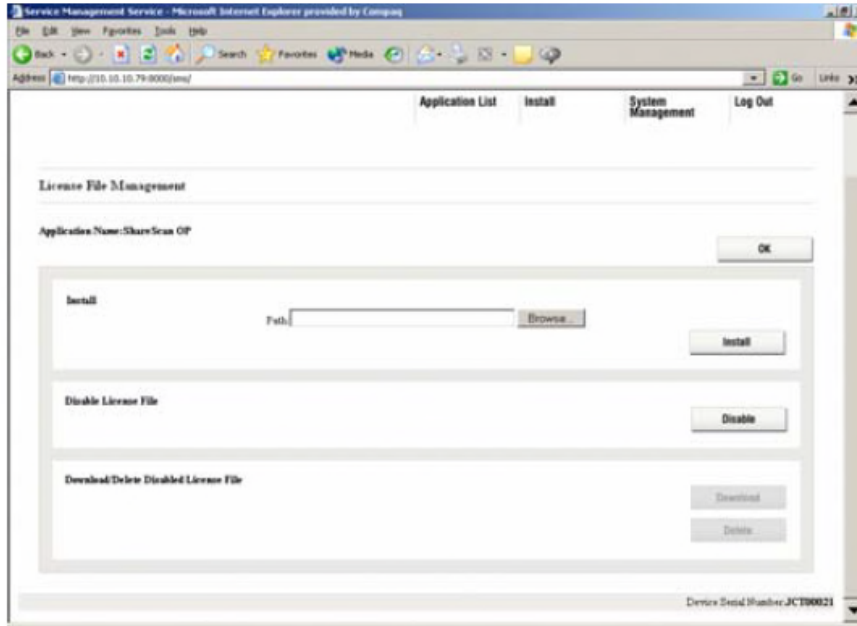
Login to SMS console using the MEAP device username and password. Ensure that the ShareScan OP radio button is selected and click to stop button to shut down the application.



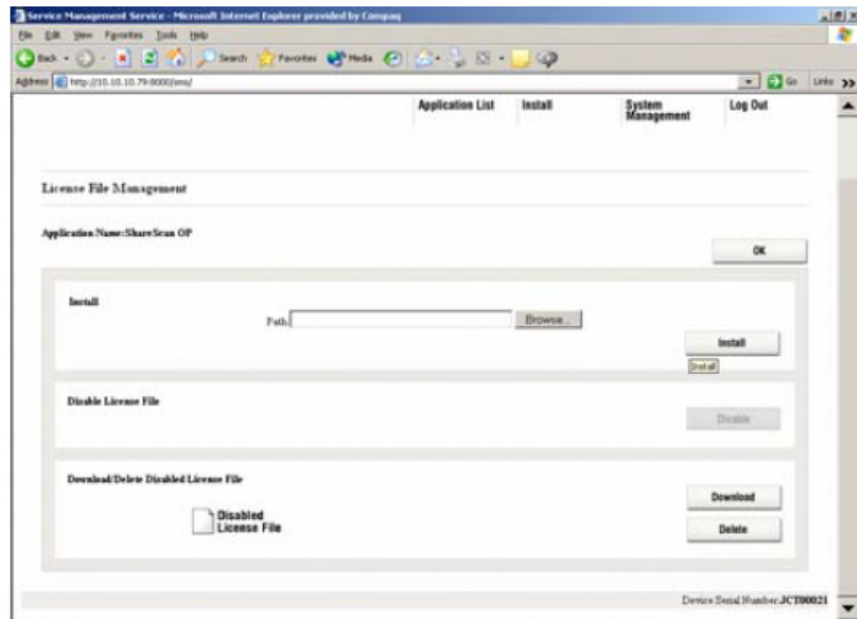
Click on the application name to get to the Application/License Information page. On the Application/License Information page click on the License Management button.



On the License File Management page, click the Disable button. This will allow the file to be safely downloaded and stored for use later.

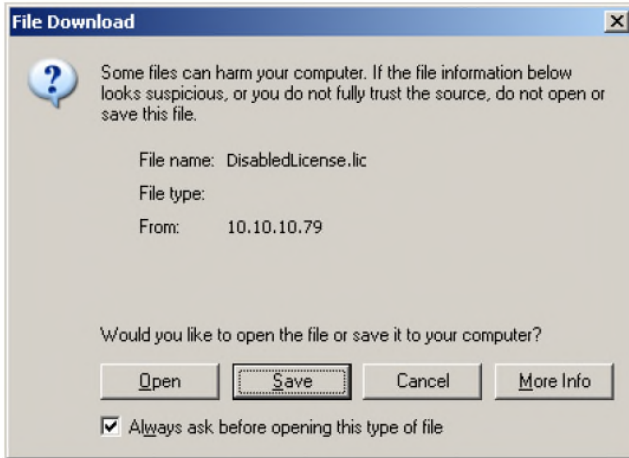


Once the license file has been disabled, it must be downloaded to a safe location for storage. If ShareScan OP is ever reinstalled this downloaded license file **MUST** be used in the installation.

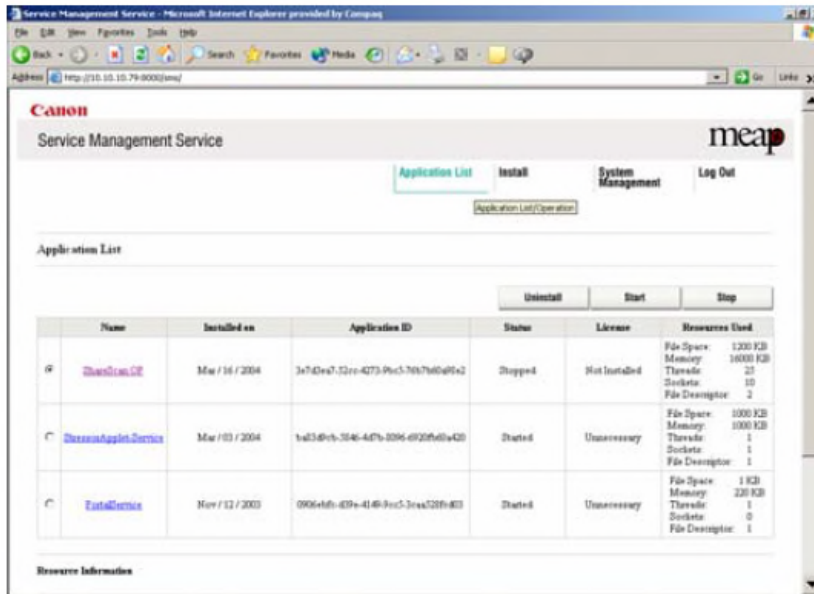


The standard Windows file download dialogue box is used for the download. It is essential that you note the name and location of the file when downloaded. The file should be renamed to identify it as has been removed from the device either with the serial number of the MEAP

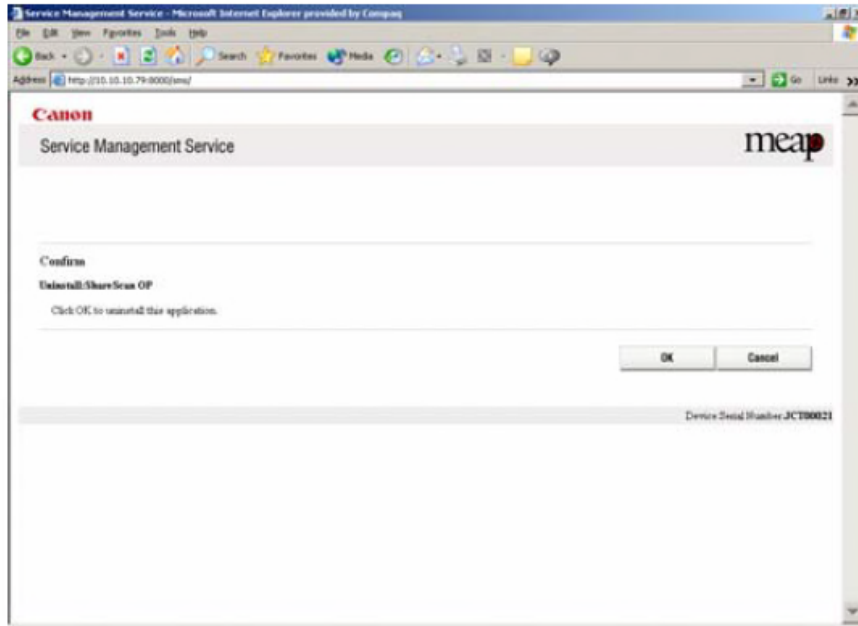
device or the location and model number (JCM04610.lic or Sales5020i.lic). The file must be renamed Disabledlicense.lic before it can be reinstalled.



Return to the SMS Application screen and ensure the radio button for ShareScan OP is selected. The Uninstall button should now be available. Select Uninstall.



Confirm that you wish to uninstall ShareScan OP. 'Click OK'



The ShareScan OP application has now been properly uninstalled and can be reinstalled using the downloaded license file. It is essential that the downloaded file be named or stored so that it can be reused if ShareScan Op is reinstalled on the device.
