# Adaptive Planning Fall 2012 Update Release

---

The Adaptive Planning Fall 2012 Update Release debuted on November 9, 2012. It includes updates to Adaptive Discovery and support for Firefox on Mac computers.

## Support for Mac Computers

Adaptive Planning can now be used on Apple Macintosh computers. The system requirements are:

- Mac OS 10.7 (Lion) or 10.8 (Mountain Lion)
- Firefox 14, 15, or 16 (we currently do not support Apple's Safari browser due to Java incompatibilities)
- Java 6 (update 1.6.0\_35 or 1.6.0\_37)

The experience of using the application on a Mac will be almost identical to using it on a PC, with one main difference: elements will be positioned in sheet and report builders using a new context menu and arrow buttons instead of drag-and-drop.

## Adaptive Discovery Enhancements

These enhancements include new features requested by customers to enable even more customization of dials and scorecards. These new capabilities include a new period-to-date setting in dials, a new scorecards editor which offers many new options for customizing scorecard dials, and differentiation between zero and null values in dials (for example, time periods for which Actuals have not yet been imported will show as uncharted on dials rather than as zero values).
