Lloyd Dugan helped found Semantic BPMN, LLC as a venture to bring semantic technologies to business process modeling and achieve the full promise of the BPMN 2.0 specification. He is also the owner of LAB Derivations (BPMN4SCA), a venture that is bringing Business Process Modeling Notation (BPMN) to application for more than just process modeling but also to the full application of modeling to include service component architecture. He is also the Chief Architect for several high visibility efforts such as, Business Process Management, Inc. (www.bpm.com) and Business Management Associates for work at the DoD Deputy Chief Management Office (DCMO) where he is contributing to the development of BPMN as the business process modeling standard for the DoD Architecture Framework Release 2.03. Mr. Dugan served as the Senior BPMN SME and Chief Architect for the Process Modeling Design Center (PMDC) for the Department of Veterans Affairs. His affiliations include: the Workflow Management Coalition (WfMC) and the WfMC's Business Process Simulation Working Group (BPSim) as well as being a member of OMG BPMN Model Interchange Working Group (MIWG). Mr. Dugan is the co-author of the Executable BPMN Chapter in the BPMN 2.0 Handbook from the WfMC and is a frequent speaker at national and international conferences on BPM and SOA.
