



# SPiRiT Program

(created using RVMS Pride Program as a guide)

One of the most important goals of the fifth grade staff at Senita Valley Elementary School is to help students establish the necessary and beneficial study skills that will ensure their success in school now and in the future. To help facilitate this goal, Senita Valley uses the SPiRiT program.

**SPiRiT** is an acronym for Student Pride in Responsibility, Integrity, and Time Management.

## **Stamp Sheets**

Every month, students will have a stamp sheet in their agenda. For every day of the school year, your child will be given a "Spirit stamp" (horse) if he/she has met the SPiRiT Program expectations. If expectations were not met, the student will receive a no stamp (the teacher will specify with their initials).

If a student loses their monthly Stamp Sheet, he/she will be given a new one but will receive a no stamp for missing materials.

## **Rewards**

Monthly - Students with all "yes" stamps for the month, will participate in a monthly celebration. Celebrations can include: movie time, extra recess activities, healthy snacks, etc.

Quarterly - Students will receive an award certificate and participate in the monthly celebration.

## **The Forgiveness Pass**

We understand that no one is perfect. This pass allows students the opportunity to have an additional day to turn in their assignment. It is still expected that the student will complete the work and turn it in the next day.

Students may not trade, share, or sell the Forgiveness Pass. A new Forgiveness Pass will be given each month. A Forgiveness Pass will not be replaced if lost.

## **Consequences**

If a student receives a “no” stamp, then the student must serve SPIRIT, a half hour (per “no” stamp) after school on the following **Wednesday or Friday from 3:00-3:30**. Students serving SPIRIT, need to report immediately to the assigned teacher (specified on the monthly SPIRIT Stamp Sheet). During SPIRIT hour, students will be expected to work on school work until they are dismissed. **It is the student’s responsibility to show their SPIRIT Stamp Sheet to their parents every night to notify when a no stamp is received. Parents must then initial the no stamp to indicate that their child will attend the following SPIRIT time (Wednesday or Friday 3:00-3:30). Arrangements for transportation will need to be made by the parents.**

## **Spirit Hour**

During SPIRIT hour, students will reflect on their behavior. Students will complete a form specifying the reasons they received a no stamp. If students finish their reflection prior to dismissal, they are expected to work on school work until they are dismissed.

# Yes and No Stamp Qualifications

## Yes Stamp

In the VAIL Schools we ACT:

**Are Respectful and Trustworthy** (honesty, speaker courtesy, friendly)  
**Care About Each other** (being a good friend, helping someone in need)  
and **Take Responsibility**

(Homework on time, daily agenda, come to class prepared (materials, books, supplies), assignments completed on time).

## No Stamp

Students do not follow the ACT statement:

**Are not Respectful and Trustworthy**

(name calling, putdowns, disrupting class, off task behavior, not respecting other's personal space)

do not **Care About Each other** and (unsportsmanlike conduct during recess)

do not **Take Responsibility**

(Homework late, forgot daily agenda, has missing materials, (marker, whiteboard, red pen, pencil, highlighters, etc), missing assignments).

Not following the ACT statement (name calling, put downs, disrupting class, off task behavior).
