New Features and Enhancements

Applicant Portal Enhancements

The following enhancements are available for the Applicant Portal as part of Sprint 22.

Multiple Coupon Codes

Note that this enhancement is immediately available for CASs and UniCASs that offer coupon codes. No configuration is required.

Applicants can now enter more than one coupon code per transaction when they select the programs they want to pay for.

API Documentation Updates

Note that this enhancement is immediately available and does not require any configuration.

Fee Waiver Statuses and Dates

This feature is available only to associations users who are utilizing income-based, service-based, and manual fee waivers, and can be activated for the current cycle upon request. This feature is not available to associations users who are utilizing automated fee waivers. Contact your Account Manager if you have any questions.

Association users can now view fee waiver information in the **Fee Waivers** sub-tab on the **Application Financials** tab. Available details include the status of an applicant's fee waiver and the dates on which the fee waiver was redeemed, expired, and awarded.

Updates to Lookup Tables	November 20, 2017	<p>Many fields in the application contain predefined answer values that users can select; for example, the Country and College Name fields both have predefined answer values. These values are housed in “lookup tables,” which are updated twice a year. The next update is scheduled for mid-fall.</p> <p>To find which lookup tables will be updated, and the changes in the predefined answer values, you can refer to your Custom Export Field Layout file, accessible under Support Resources in WebAdMIT.</p>
Updates to College Coursework Credit Value Entries	Winter	<p>For CASs that collect college coursework, the Applicant Portal will be updated to allow applicants to enter course credit values in one numeric field. This field will also limit applicants from entering more than two digits after a decimal.</p> <p>Currently, applicants are required to enter course credit values in two fields: a numeric field for the whole course credit and a drop-down including preset fractional values.</p>

Resolved Issues

WebAdMIT

The following issues were resolved in WebAdMIT as part of the Sprint 22 release. The codes in parentheses correspond to the identifiers in our issue tracking system.

1. An issue that caused the **PCAT Official – Official Received Date** field to function incorrectly in the List Manager was resolved. (WA-5056)
2. An issue where certain Experiences data was not deleted correctly was resolved. (WA-5163)
