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New Features and Enhancements

Applicant Portal Enhancements

The following enhancements are available for WebAdMIT as part of Sprint 26.

New Military History Tile in Applicant Portal

This enhancement is available to all CASs and UniCASs for the 2018-2019 cycle. Please see your Account Manager for more information.

The Applicant Portal now supports a **Military History** tile in the **Personal Information** section. This tile includes four possible blocks: U.S. Armed Forces Status, Military Status at Enrollment, Military Branch, and Military Discharge.

Applicant responses are collected under **Military History** in the **Biographic Information** section of the **Full Application PDF**.

New Disciplinary Action Question Block in Applicant Portal

This enhancement is available to all CASs and UniCASs for the 2018-2019 cycle. Please see your Account Manager for more information.

The Applicant Portal now supports a **Disciplinary Action** block under **Other Information** in the **Personal Information** section. This allows applicants to self-report and explain any disciplinary actions taken against them for conduct violations. This enhancement includes language specifically targeting actions taken in high school.

New Misdemeanor or Felony Block in Applicant Portal

This enhancement is available to all CASs and UniCASs for the 2018-2019 cycle. Please see your Account Manager for more information.

The Applicant portal now supports a **Misdemeanor or Felony** block under **Other Information** in the **Personal Information** section. This enhancement allows applicants to self-report and explain any felonies or misdemeanors they have been convicted of. Previously, there were questions that target felonies and misdemeanors separately; this question block asks about both in a single question.

Added Ability to Prevent Multiple Program Submissions in One Transaction

This enhancement is available as an option for all CASs and UniCASs starting with the next cycle launch. Please see your Account Manager for more information.

CASs now have the option to allow multiple applications per submission, or restrict to a single application per submission. Previously, applicants could use the **Submit All** button to submit to multiple schools/organizations

at once. This is still the default option; however, CASs and UniCASs can now restrict applicants to one submission at a time. When activated, this option causes applicants to initiate a separate transaction for each application.

New Lookup Table Values Available

This enhancement is immediately available for CASs and UniCASs. No configuration is required.

Many fields in the application contain predefined answer values that users can select; for example, the **Country** and **College Name** fields both have predefined answer values. These values are housed in “lookup tables,” which are updated twice a year. The new lookup table values are now available in the Applicant Portal for applicants to select from.

WebAdMIT Enhancements

The following enhancements are available for WebAdMIT as part of Sprint 26.

Number of Lists Allowed for Use in Composite Lists Expanded

This enhancement is immediately available for CASs and UniCASs. No configuration is required.

To allow for even more advanced queries, the number of lists allowed for inclusion in a composite list has been increased from three to five.

New Military History Status Data Available in WebAdMIT

Starting with the 2018-19 cycle, this enhancement will be available to all CASs using the new Military History Tile described above.

In conjunction with the new Military History Tile in the Applicant Portal, this data is available in WebAdMIT on the **Applicant Details Page**. It can be found on the **Other Information** subpanel in the **Personal Information** panel. It is also available in the List Manager and Export Manager.

New Disciplinary Action Information Available in WebAdMIT

Starting with the 2018-19 cycle, this enhancement will be available to all CASs using new **Disciplinary Action** block described above.

In conjunction with the new **Disciplinary Action** block on the Applicant Portal, this information is available in WebAdMIT on the **Applicant Details Page**. It can be found on the **Academic** subpanel in the **Infractions** panel. This information is also available in the **Background** field grouping in the **List Manager** and **Export Manager**.



This information is also available in the **Background** field grouping in the **List Manager** and **Export Manager**.

Updated Text on Transcripts Subpanel

This enhancement is immediately available for CASs and UniCASs. No configuration is required.

For CASs that use verification lite or applicant-reported transcripts, and support GPAs by Transcript, there is subtext that indicates the coursework has not been verified. This text has been updated to read *“These GPAs were entered from transcripts by CAS or self-reported by the applicant. No coursework has been verified”*.

New Lookup Table Values Available

Note that this enhancement is immediately available for CASs and UniCASs. No configuration is required.

Many fields in the application contain predefined answer values that users can select; for example, the **Country** and **College Name** fields both have predefined answer values. These values are housed in “lookup tables,” which are updated twice a year. The new lookup table values are now available in WebAdMIT. These values are included in the List Manager and Export Manager. All new course subjects are added to GPA calculations, which are also available in WebAdMIT.

This field will also limit applicants from entering more than two digits after a decimal.</p> <p>Currently, applicants are required to enter course credit values in two fields: a numeric field for the whole course credit and a drop-down including preset fractional values.</p>

WebAdMIT

The following issues were resolved in WebAdMIT as part of the Sprint 26 release. The codes in parentheses correspond to the identifiers in our issue tracking system.

1. An issue preventing emails from being sent via BCC was resolved. (WA-5215)
2. An issue causing users to be redirected to the search page after sending an individual email has been resolved. (WA-5214)
3. An issue causing email previews to be saved as drafts was resolved. (WA-5210)
4. An issue causing some applicants to be exported with a blank row in CSV files was resolved. (WA-5186)
5. An issue preventing search criteria to be honored in **Search Correspondence** was resolved. (WA-4970)
